The focus would be on **mycobacteria and mycobacterial diseases**. The workshop faculty would comprise experts from the South Asian University as well as the Colorado State University, CO, USA. The workshop will run for 2.5 days (Feb 20, 2017 to Feb 22, 2017) in the South Asian University, in Chanakyapuri, New Delhi. The workshop would have theory lectures as well as laboratory exercises.
