About the Role:

Requirements:

Postgraduate in any Social Sciences discipline with a minimum of 55% marks. Preference will be given to candidates with NET/M.Phil./Ph.D.

- Preference will be given to candidates with a strong academic record and who exhibit the capacity to undertake collaborative research.
- Strong writing and communication skills, knowledge of quantitative and qualitative research methods, and familiarity with statistical tools (e.g., Excel, SPSS, R) are also desirable.

- Selected candidate is expected to make South Asian University the main place of work during the tenure of the project and is expected to work dedicatedly in collaboration with
