Applications are invited for the post of two **Project Assistants/Junior Research Fellows (JRFs)** in the DBT Wellcome Trust India Alliance Intermediate Fellowship entitled “**Stop-codon mutations and stop-codon dysfunction – role in physiology and cancer**” under the supervision of Dr. Sonam Dhamija, Faculty of Life Sciences and Biotechnology, South Asian University, New Delhi.

**Qualifications:** The minimum qualification is a 4-year Bachelor’s or a Postgraduate degree (M.Sc./M.Tech.) in life sciences/biotechnology/basic sciences. Prior experience in mammalian cell culture, basic molecular biology, cloning and expression studies is desirable.
