01 The Threat Landscape



Understanding the global and national security environment as it directly bears on corporate and industrial operations, state-sponsored threats, external intelligence operations targeting Indian industry, and internal vulnerabilities.



02 Corporate Intelligence & Conceptual Framework



The intelligence cycle, open-source intelligence (OSINT), basics of intelligence collection and analysis, and how intelligence thinking transforms the quality of executive decision-making.



03 Counterintelligence & Information Security



Protecting trade secrets, neutralizing surveillance, securing digital infrastructure, managing social media exposure, and building a counterintelligence posture that is proportionate and legally sound.



04 Protective Security & Access Control



Securing senior leadership and sensitive assignments, access control frameworks, character and antecedent verification of contractual workers, and the application of behavioural science to identify suspicious activity.



05 Crisis Management & Negotiation



De-escalation frameworks, managing mass protests and social disruptions, conflict resolution under pressure, negotiation strategy, and communication management during live security incidents.



06 People, Culture & Institutional Resilience



Gender sensitization and legal compliance, anger and stress management for high-responsibility roles, and building a workplace culture where security awareness is institutional rather than incidental.



07 Industrial Security & Audit



Comprehensive security audit frameworks, threat identification for corporate assets, area survey methodology, and the standards that govern industrial security at the highest level.
